- 1. AQAR 2015-16 submitted in November, 2016.
- Monthly Performance Report (MPR) implemented and regular submission was monitored and its evaluation was conveyed to the principal.

- Result Analysis was conducted and the consolidated report was submitted for further analysis.
- Two new courses BBA and B.Sc. Computer Science were started. Applications are also sent for more courses.
- Management Information System was fully implemented for admission, attendance maintenance and office administration.
- LMS platforms were insisted in the teaching learning process.
- Faculties were encouraged to have personal YouTube channels/ blogs and websites and departments were encouraged to start their own YouTube channel. Some of the departments already started their channel

- The book bank facilities within the departments have been strengthened and students were encouraged to use these facilities.
- Different training programs were organized by IQAC for teaching/office staff and students after careful analysis of the existing need.
- IQAC initiated the conduct of Value education programmes, remedial classes, mentoring and awareness classes in every department.
- The campus has been made more eco-friendly/ green initiatives with the active participation of Nature Club.
