Orientation Programme

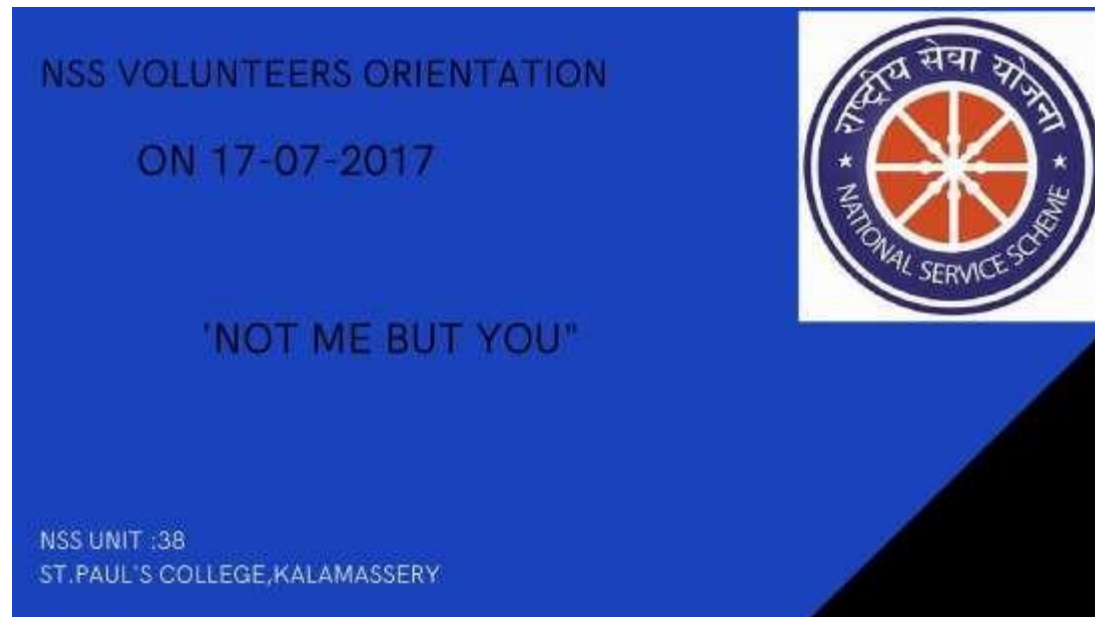

Outcome: The camp produced a plethora of mesmerizing experiences, enthralling cultural programmes and ever lasting real life learnings.

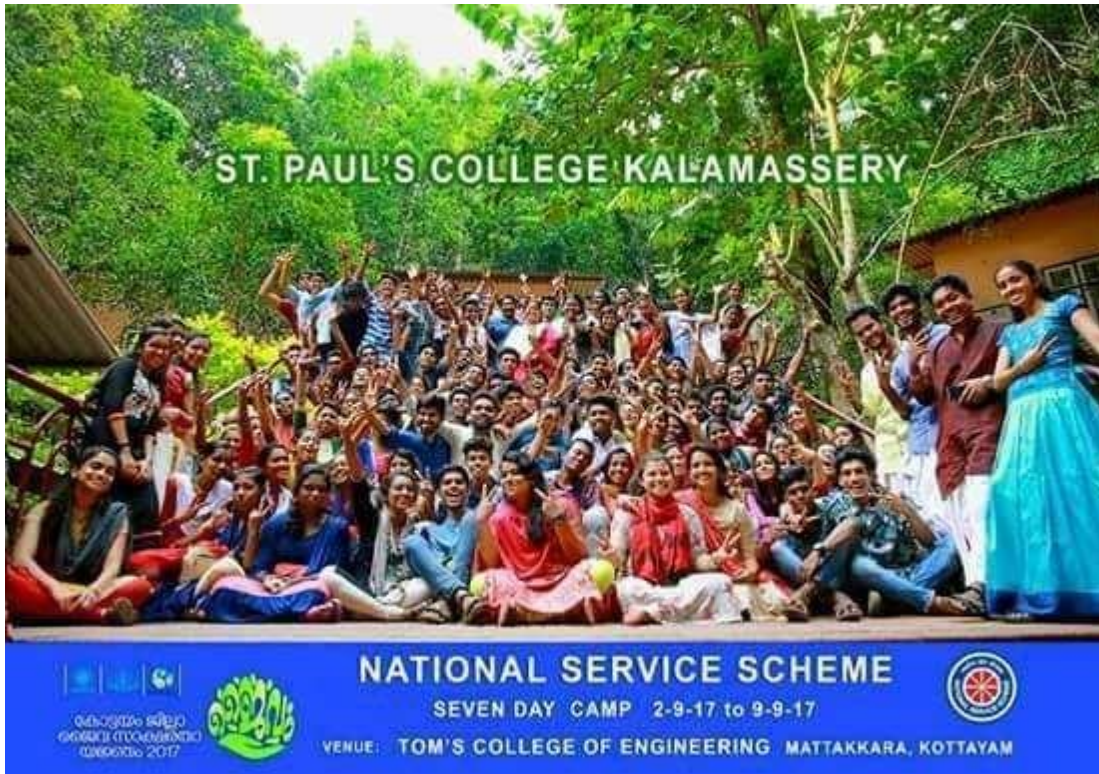

Fruit Tree Saplings Distribution

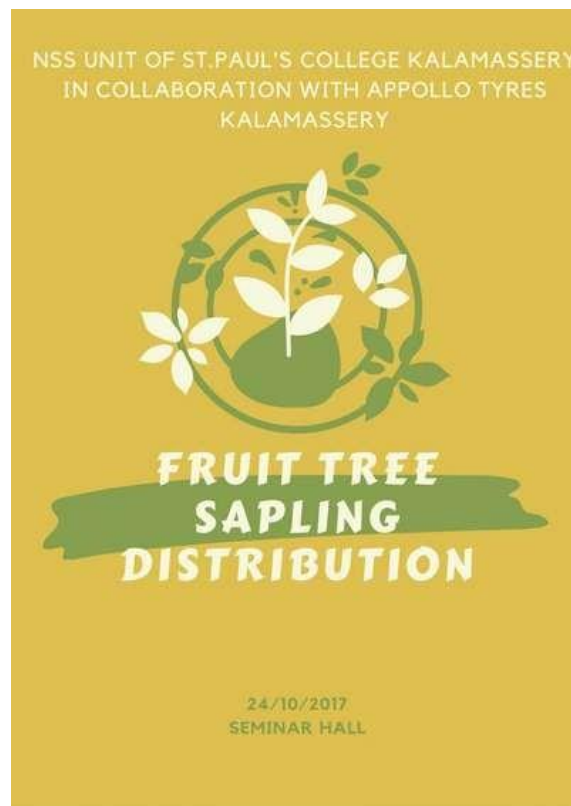
