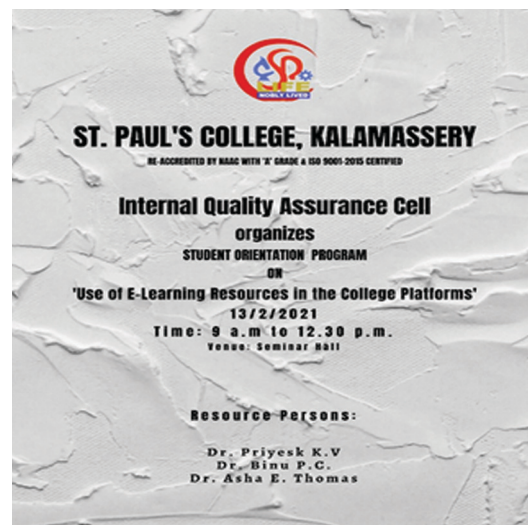

During the year 2020-21 IQAC had initiated two social research projects for extending its support to the underserved communities. These projects were:

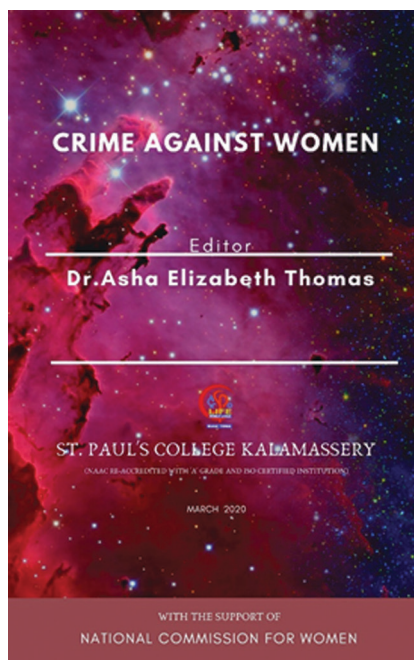
1. Understanding the educational attainments of tribal communities in Kerala giving special focus to Wayanad and Idukki.
