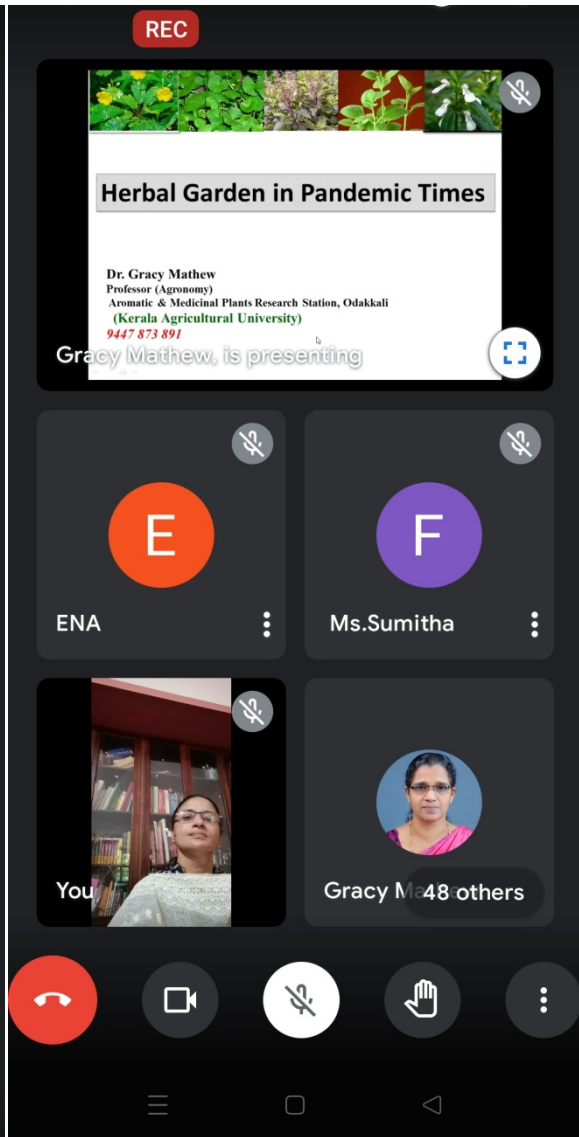
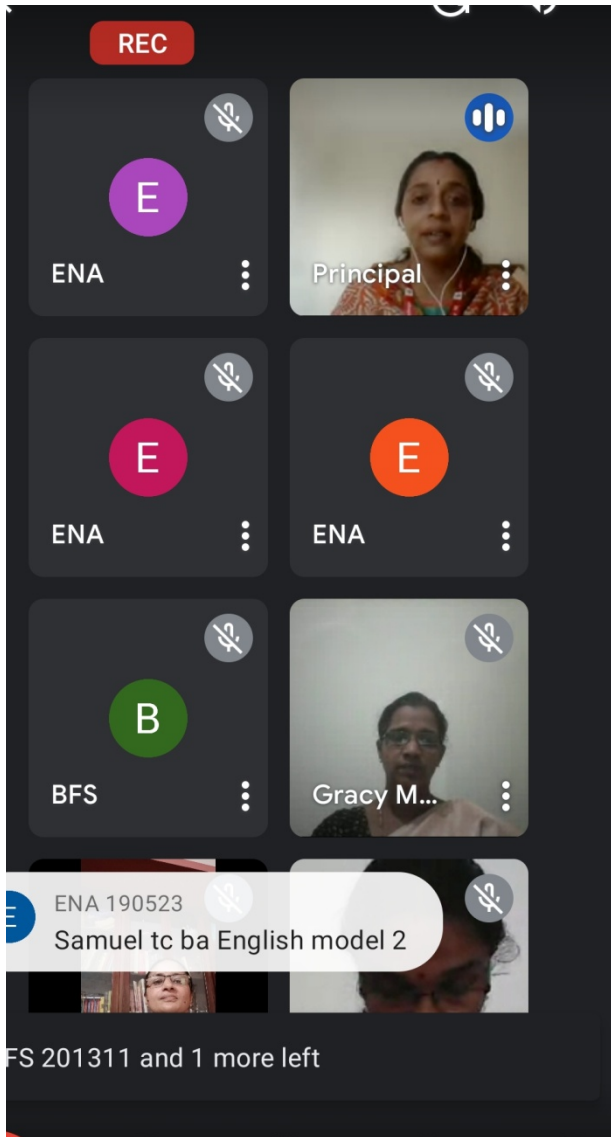

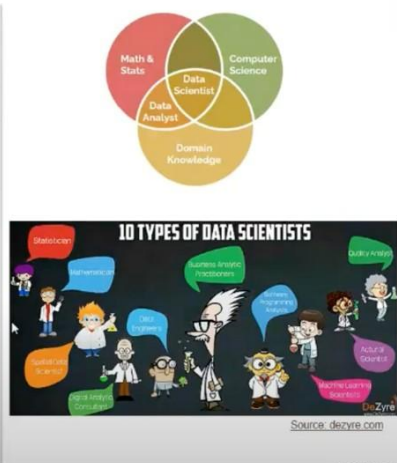

### Keep in mind...

- Importance of Exploratory Data analysis
  - Do we only test ideas from data or do we also get ideas from analyzing data?
  - “Data by themselves do not tell anything unless you engage with data in a dialogue which is theory inspired”
- Rules Vs Exceptions
  - Graphical methods allows us to look at patterns within the data without ignoring its total variations and in particular, exceptions to the rule
- Data = Fit + Residuals
  - Fit is the preliminary model employed to remove key patterns from the data so as to look more carefully at the residual variation

2. Reduce the clutter:
  - Any unnecessary distracting visual elements reduce effectiveness
3. Integrate the text and the graph:
  - Visualizations are constructed to complement the text and at the same time contain enough info to stand out

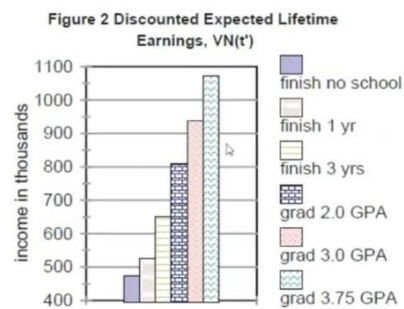
